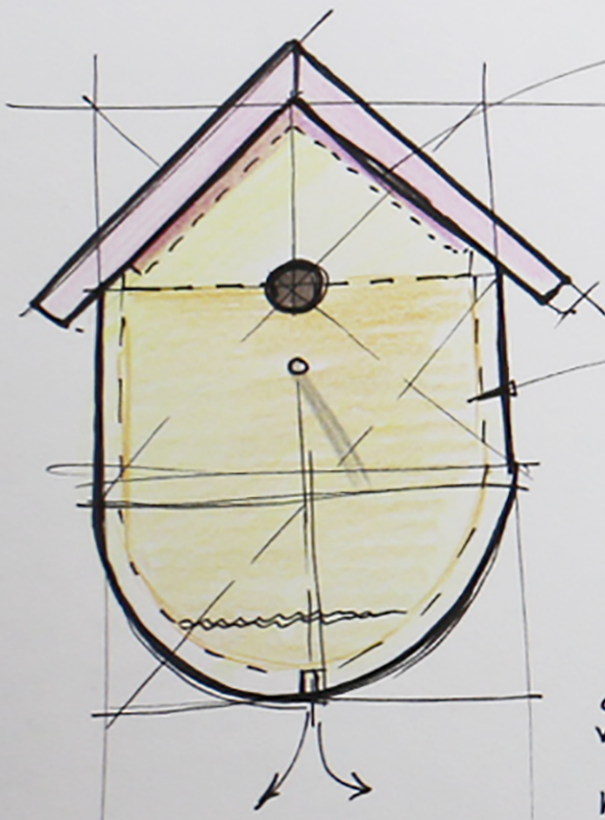


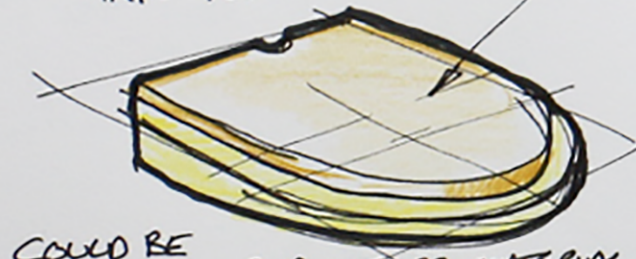
HOLE SIZES

- Ø25 - BLUE TITS
- Ø28 - GREAT TITS TREE SPARROWS
- Ø32 - HOUSE SPARROWS
- Ø45 - STARLINGS

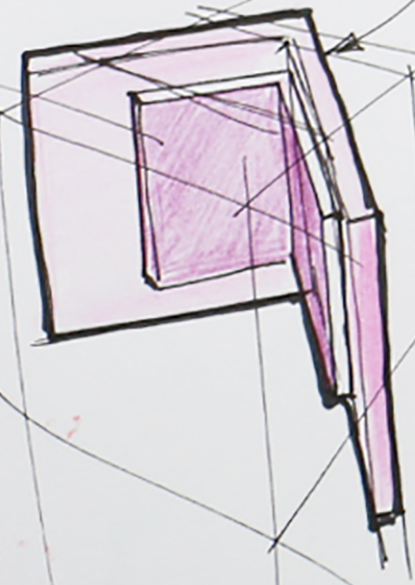


INTERNAL BLOCK TO STOP ROOF FROM SLIPPING

INTERNAL ARCHES TO FIX CURVED SIDE/BASE INTO PLACE



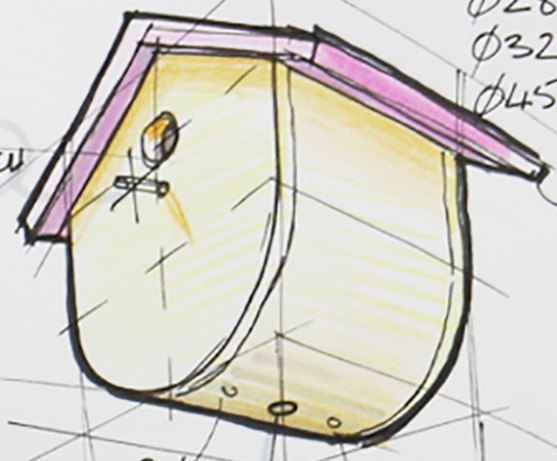
COULD BE MADE USING 2 PIECES OF MATERIAL OR MACHINED OUT OF ONE PIECE OF MATERIAL.



POSSIBLY ADD ROOFING FELT ON TOP. OR RECYCLED CAL INNER TUBE MATERIAL.

VIEWED HIGH UP



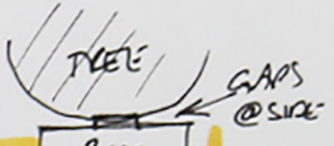
REMOVABLE BUT SHOULD BE LOCKED DOWN

METHOD OF JOINING TO VERTICAL SURFACE - TREE, POST, WALL, ETC PERMANENT FIX BUT CAN BE REMOVED IF REQUIRED.



DRAIN HOLE/S. RECOMMENDED.

ON A POLE



JAGGY MATERIALS (ROSES, ETC.)

BIRD DETAILS WILL DETERMINE MUCH OF THE SPECIFIC THAT HAVE NOT YET BEEN CONFIRMED



GRILL

BIRDS FALL THROUGH

Ø OF PLUG TO BE CHECKED

PLUG @ BOTTOM TO ALLOW WATER/WASTE OUT

MATERIALS
BIRD FRIENDLY
ECO FRIENDLY
WEATHER PROOF
LONG LASTING.

From 15mm THICK WATERPROOF

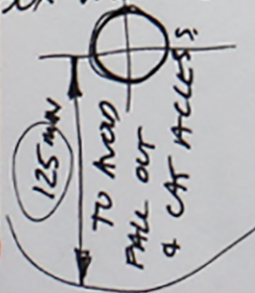
ROUGH SURFACE INSIDE TO AID CHICKS CLIMB OUT.

UNTREATED OR WATER BASED PRESERVATIVE eg "SALODIN" (cuprenol)

CUTSIDE ONLY & NOT ROUND THE ENTRANCE HOLE

DILUTED LATEX BASED PAINTS (NOT TOO DARK) HEAT CONCERNS

DDEPTH NEST SIZE
PARENT & CHICK SIZE
& HOLE ACCESS
BOX WIDTH ≈ 150mm



JOINING METHOD
AS ECO FRIENDLY AS POSSIBLE
NO NEGATIVE IMPACT OF ENVIRONMENT & BIRDS THEMSELVES
GALVANISED (OR COARSE?) NAILS ARE BEST PRACTICE.

DO NOT ADD A PERCH! PREDATORS USE THE PERCH

- PREDATORS: CATS, SQUIRRELS, MICE, STORRS
- SMALL BIRDS - HOLE Ø25mm EXCLUDES LARGER BIRDS

MANY BOXES WITH VARIETY OF HOLES (SIZES) TO ACCOMMODATE BIRDS RANGE.

- CLEAN - BOILING WATER AFTER BIRDS HAVE LEFT.
- BOX CAN BE USED AS ROOSTING LOCATION AFTER/BETWEEN NESTING SEASONS.
